DELIGHTFUL KISS was in hand while trailing to the second turn, began to close the gap leaving the three eighths, swung five wide while being urged at the quarter pole, engaged the runnerup in upper stretch, battled to mid stretch then began to inch away under steady handling. AWESOME GEM was unhurried to the half mile pole, began to close ground when roused into the second turn, shifted four wide for room and pushed to the front into the stretch, was collared by the winner nearing mid stretch, resisted that one briefly but then was no match while easily best of the others. SARATOGA'S MAGIC was allowed to settle for five furlongs, bid two wide on the second turn to briefly loom a factor to the stretch then did not threaten the top two. ASPERITY tracked the leaders to the half mile pole, was fanned four wide while offering his best bid on the second turn but weakened through the stretch. ASSESSMENT pressed the pace three wide to the second turn, remained three wide to the stretch then tired in the drive. OUR PARTNER never far back while saving ground, tried to rally inside on the second turn but tired in the drive. VICTORIAN PRINCE (IRE) set a pressured pace to the second turn, was overtaken into the stretch and stopped through the final furlong.
