**Footnotes**

BEAMER BEE broke alertly and pressed HAVANNA SMOKE from the outside while lugging out, continued to lug on the turn, challenged for command once in the stretch, drew clear briefly but was all out to last. DOM BA DOOMBA was taken in hand early and settled off the pace, angled three wide on the turn and set out after the leaders then rallied steadily from the outside in the lane. COMIC RHYTHM tracked the pace from the inside to the stretch and went evenly late. INSPIRED CANDI trailed early, saved ground and came on without being a serious factor. HAVANNA SMOKE set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and weakened. VICTORIAN GIRL raced close up early then came up empty while three wide on the turn. QUICKFOOT was never a factor.
