CASHMERE MIST stalked the pace to the turn, bid three then four wide to the stretch, dueled the runnerup from mid stretch to the sixteenth marker then outfinished that one. GREAT NEWS was hustled up early but was crowded inside and forced to take back nearing the half mile pole, was last into the turn and shifted out, made a strong run three then five wide to the stretch, got almost to terms to mid stretch but did not switch leads in the final furlong and was outfinished. UNION PRIVEE had no speed, raced in the two path to the stretch but failed to offer the needed late response. ELEGANT LOOQ set a pressured pace to the turn, was overtaken by the winner into the stretch and weakened in the drive. MISS TRIPLE PLAY tracked the pace to the turn then saved ground to no avail. A LITTLE POLISH pressed the action from the three path to the stretch then tired.
