ROULETTE IT ROLL broke alertly and set all the pace to the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and held on desperately. LIL ANGELINA hesitated and broke a bit slow, tracked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then closed with a late surge to just miss. HOOSIER HONEY had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch then shifted out and closed steadily in the final sixteenth. JUMANAH pressed the pace to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MISS SMOKE SIGNALS chased the pace three wide to the stretch but gave way in the drive. NADA JOKE prompted the pace to the turn then tried to lug out, became rank under strong handling and dropped back steadily. FANCEY ENDEVOR trailed throughout.
