Footnotes

BUSHRANGER NED (IRE) took back at the start and trailed to the stretch from just off the rail, found room through heavy traffic nearing the furlong pole, split JAPANESE COMET and BOLD MEETING inside the sixteenth pole and won driving. BRIANVILLE raced well placed two wide and between horses to the stretch, responded late and was gradually gaining. BOLD MEETING raced unhurried early, offered a quick bid from the rail leaving the half mile pole, challenged on the second turn, slipped back slightly into the stretch but kept to his task and held the show. JAPANESE COMET set all of the pace from off the rail, turned back BOLD MEETING in the upper stretch but slackened in the late going. PERFECT KIVA was not asked for speed early, raced four wide throughout and lacked the needed rally. COULD BE DREAM'N stalked the pace outside a three horse spread to the stretch and lacked a closing rally. DEL MAR EXPRESS pressed the pace from the three path for six furlongs and gave way. CYPRESS SAM stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn and gave out.
