MOUDEZ (IRE) was unhurried for a half mile, bid two wide into the second turn, swung out five wide into the stretch then closed with a strong rally to win going away. NINER GENIUS tracked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, got to terms in mid stretch but was outrun by the winner while best of the rest. CASUAL OBSESSION bobbled slightly at the start but quickly recovered and set the pace for six furlongs but was tiring in the final furlong. SUDDEN EXCESS prompted the pace to the second turn, offered his best try two wide to the stretch then lost his punch. IDLE CHATTER had no speed, advanced inside on the second turn but flattened out in the stretch. TWAIN'S TITAN was unhurried for a half mile then saved ground to the stretch but lacked a closing response. MR. KATZ settled mid pack for five furlongs, was three wide to the stretch then gave way. MR MUNSEY stalked the pace to the half, got shuffled back between rivals leaving the three eighths and gave way.
