Footnotes

CRAFTY STARLIT tracked the pace from the outset in hand, was sent after the lead from between horses nearing the quarter pole, took a clear advantage at the furlong grounds and held driving. JAYLO'S MARK set the pace from the inside throughout, could not match strides with the winner in the upper stretch but held well for the place. CASSABLANCA (GB) lagged early from the rail, advanced four wide on the second turn but lost some of her punch in the lane. SCREAMIN EXPRESS had no early speed, was set down on the second turn and finished steadily without reaching contention. MOTHER'S SAUCE was permitted to settle early from the rail, offered a menacing bid three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the lane. CEE THE LADY raced two wide throughout and failed to respond. CUVEE BLUSH pressed the pace for a half mile and gave out.
