MUSIC APPEAL stumbled a few strides out of the gate, recovered and settled to the half, moved up between rivals to the second turn, rallied two wide to push to the front to mid stretch and was kept to task to the line. COLE IS THE MAN had no speed after easing down from the four path to the two path midway on the first bend, responded when asked two wide on the second turn, could not impact the winner while besting the rest. GOOD DEFENSE was five wide into the first turn, eased down to the three path, settled to the half, got fanned five wide on the second turn then was gaining ground belatedly in the drive. FORTY CTS contested the pace from the rail for six furlongs but tired in the stretch. DEPUTY J DUB saved ground throughout but did not rally and was not a threat. WHATAWAYTOGO attended the pace outside of FORTY CTS early, was between rivals on the backstretch but gave way after six furlongs. SLEW BLINK stalked the pace three wide to the half then began to tire on the second turn and gave out in the stretch.
