Footnotes

PERFECT HOSTESS broke a step slow but gradually gained a short lead in the opening quarter, dueled into the stretch, disposed of SALSA EXPRESS past the furlong pole and held driving. OUR ROAD SCHOLAR was never too far back, saved ground on the turn and finished steadily while directly behind the winner. SALSA EXPRESS broke alertly then settled just off the dueling leaders, offered a bold bid three wide into the lane, to terms with the winner a furlong out then could not match strides. ADVANCE TICKET dueled outside the winner to the stretch and weakened. RULE THE STORM settled early, raced just off the rail on the turn but failed to rally. TAIL SPIN TOPPER lacked good early speed, saved ground and never reached serious contention. KENDRA RAE was permitted to settle early then failed to respond while three wide on the turn.
