SENIOR CITIZEN was permitted to settle early but was never far back, saved ground into the lane, rallied steadily and was up late. MALIBU'S REFRAIN dueled early outside GOLDEN GAYLORD, edged clear on the turn, let to the deep stretch but was tagged late. GOLDEN GAYLORD dueled early, moved outside MALIBU'S REFRAIN into the turn, challenged at the furlong pole but could not get up. SUPER SALESMAN settled early, advanced four wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. SIERRA SEVEN lacked good early speed, moved closer three wide on the turn, rallied steadily in the lane to the final stages then lacked room behind a wall of horses. MUSICAESTROPLEASE settled in pack, came four wide to the stretch but lacked the needed rally. NO NIBBLING lacked good early speed, went four wide on the turn but had only a mild rally. OUR BONANZA was slow in the early going, steadied off NORCAL

INVADER into the turn, recovered and came on steadily late. COUSIN BRUNO pressed the pace three wide to the stretch and weakened. DOWN RIVER ROAD lacked early speed, raced four wide on the turn and did not rally. NORCAL INVADER broke alertly but fell back steadily from the inside. RUNNING BEAR showed little.
