GREEN CAT broke cleanly and was unhurried to the turn, circled rivals four wide to the stretch and closed steadily to gain command late and drew clear driving. RED CREME broke slow and quickly switched to the inside, moved up steadily from the rail to the stretch, eased out and finished willingly. JERRY'S FEVER pressed the pace outside, could not go with MATTHEW L in the upper stretch but kept to his task. RICK THE BARTENDER lagged early, raced three wide on the turn and came on late. WINTER WARLOCK saved ground to no avail. MATTHEW L set the pace from the inside, spurted clear in the upper stretch but shortened stride at mid stretch. MELANZANA stalked the pace three wide but came up empty in the lane. MUTINY BAY was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn and came on a bit in the final stages. FUNNYCUS broke a step slow then raced up between horses to reach contention in the opening quarter, fell back on the turn then went evenly in the lane. REZAR had no speed and was eased through the lane.
