STORMY SURGE raced in reserve to the second turn, rallied while angling three wide into the lane, gained command past the furlong pole and drew clear driving. ZAPPA lagged to the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished fastest. SHEM dueled from the rail to the furlong pole and slackened. LANG FIELD dueled two wide into the lane and weakened. DANGEROUS DEVIL settled early from the rail but lacked a response while two wide on the second turn. WAY TOO MUCH was always outrun.
