Footnotes

UNUSUAL SMOKE was permitted to settle from the rail into the first turn but was always within striking distance, was boxed on the rail from the half mile pole until nearing the quarter pole, swung out to split foes three wide into the lane, quickly drew clear in the upper stretch, appeared to be headed near the line but was back up in the final stride. NAUGHTY CAL raced unhurried to the backstretch while off the rail, moved closer into the second turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch, rallied steadily to forge to the front in the late stages but was outnoddod on the line. CHAVEZ RAVINE ducked in sharply at the start then was corrected and raced up to press the pace two wide under a very snug hold, took command on the second turn and briefly drew clear but weakened once in the stretch. CHINESE COMET was not asked for speed early, advanced four wide on the second turn but went evenly in the lane. BUCKS HIDDEN ASSET stalked the pace outside a four horse spread into and on the first turn, gradually slipped back on the backstretch, was two wide into the lane but had no late response. MOAMBE showed little. MOM'S BALLET pressed the pace three wide early, slipped back slightly on the backstretch, challenged again four wide on the second turn but gave out in the lane. JACK STORY was bumped solidly by DEPUTY PRIZE at the start to fall well behind then showed no speed. GREY ALYCATT set the pace from the rail to the head of the lane and stopped. DEPUTY PRIZE was forced in sharply at the start and bumped with JACK STORY and fell well back then had no speed.
