### Footnotes

A CAT NAMED SNIPE pressed the pace to the turn, rallied three wide and pushed to the front into the stretch, drew clear to mid stretch then was under vigorous handling while tiring to hold. SYDNEY AGAIN chased the pace from the rail to the stretch then was closing steadily but just missed. SEARCHFORTHETRUTH broke a bit slow and was pinched a bit at the start, raced two wide to the stretch then closed ground belatedly. RANDOM MEMO was outrun to the turn, came three wide to the stretch then also was gaining ground without being a real threat. FULL POWER AHEAD had no speed and was not a factor. VADERATOR was hustled to the front early, set the pace to the middle of the turn, was overtaken into the stretch and gave out in the drive.
