PROUD CAJUN was settled to the half, bid two then three wide on the second turn, pushed to the front a furlong out then held on under vigorous handling. SEATTLE DELEGATE chased the leaders to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then dug in gamely late and just missed. MUQS QUEST had no speed and settled for a half mile, was roused into the second turn but was forced to circle four wide to the stretch, responded when straightened for the drive and finished willingly. OKIE DOKIE PETEY attended the pace in the early stages then prompted FOR CONTRAST to the second turn, raced two then three wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive. KISS MY CROWN was also settled for a half mile, came three wide to the stretch but failed to offer the needed response. FOR CONTRAST was hustled and dueled to the backstretch, pushed away to the second turn, let to the stretch but tired in the lane. COURT DECISION was always outrun.
