TOUCH THE SUN broke outward and steadied but quickly recovered to make the lead leaving the chute, was well rated off the rail, met a bid from CARR CREEK on the second turn, responded gamely and was edging away again at the line. CARR CREEK tracked the winner from the outset, challenged outside into the lane, dueled but slackened in the late stages. FORMULA GOLD settled early, raced three wide to the stretch then lacked the needed response. LIQUID ASSET was rank and hard to settle from the rail to the second turn, remained inside into the lane but did not rally. STEFANELLI raced unhurried early three wide, was four wide on the second turn but had no response in the lane. REFORMED lacked early speed or a closing response while three wide on second turn. GOLDEN JET saved ground throughout but had no speed.
