**Footnotes**

ALL THE MAGIC stalked the leaders to the second turn, had to wait behind DUX to mid turn then rallied inside that one to the stretch, dueled to deep stretch then gamely bested MIGHTY MARINO late. MIGHTY MARINO was four wide to the backstretch, stalked to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, dueled the winner to deep stretch but was outgamed late. RED MAN RUN was five wide into the first turn, chased the leaders to the half, offered a bid four wide to the stretch but could not sustain the needed response. KING BILL had no speed and settled, got fanned four wide on the second turn, was a factor to mid stretch then finished evenly. JOHNNY HOT ROD was three deep early, settled to the second turn, offered a bid outside a rival to the stretch but lost his punch in the final furlong. SEDONA RIDGE had no speed and saved ground to no avail. OLYMPIC PIRATE prompted the pace to the second turn then stopped. DUX set the pace off the rail for six furlongs then also stopped. TANNER'S EVENT was forced out six deep on the first turn, settled to the half then gave way after five furlongs and stopped in the stretch. CAPE COLOANE hesitated in the gate, broke slow, trailed throughout then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
