**Footnotes**

SEE ZO GO broke alertly and elected to take back just off TRIPLE ACTION from the inside and tracked that rival to the second turn, took command two wide into the lane then held gamely. FU PEG HE RAT was permitted to settle in the early stages and saved ground to the backstretch, continued inside and gradually advanced to be a major factor on the second turn, shifted out for the drive and closed late from between horses. GLOBAL GLOW was forwardly placed from off the rail, launched his best bid three wide into the stretch and seemed to lose some of his punch. THE TOUR DIRECTOR raced unhurried early, was just off the rail on the second turn but finished steadily from the inside in the final quarter. TRIPLE ACTION set all of the pace from off the rail to the head of the lane but lacked the needed late response. TROPICAL HEAT settled early, raced three wide to the stretch but could manage only a mild gain. DO WHAT U DARE settled early, was four wide on the second turn and did not rally. SURFER DAVE failed to respond from the inside on the second turn. MICKEY'S HOUSE was well placed for a half mile and gave way four wide on the second turn.
