Footnotes

KATIE'S DAN (NZ) never far back for six furlongs, rallied two wide to the stretch, shifted out, responded to pressure in mid stretch, split foes and bested GREY STORM in the final sixteenth. GREY STORM was unhurried while three wide to the stretch, rallied three wide to the stretch, dueled to deep stretch but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. SPEED ROUSER prompted the pace for a half mile, moved up outside of NORTHERN J C and got to terms with that one on the second turn, dueled to mid stretch but was tiring in the late stages. NORTHERN J C set the pace to the second turn, met the bid from SPEED ROUSER to the stretch, remained a factor to mid stretch then also tired. AWESOME JARED tracked the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then was crowded inside leaving mid stretch, checked and weakened. PREMIERE FLYER was three wide throughout and came up empty when asked for speed.
