**Footnotes**

RED DANGER steadied sharply in the opening strides then recovered and slipped through inside FREE RETURN to gain command in the opening quarter, battled that rival to the head of the lane and gradually pulled clear to win driving. DEEP REFLECTION settled early, saved ground to rally into the stretch but could not threaten the winner. FREE RETURN broke on top but was headed by RED DANGER in the opening quarter, battled that rival from the outside to the head of the lane and weakened. APOLLO TEN broke slow and raced unhurried, advanced three wide on the turn then flattened out in the final furlong. DASHING broke slow and lagged, raced well off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. DOCTOR PARK lacked early speed then saved ground to no avail. BRUDDA CLYDE stalked the pace from off the rail to the turn, stopped and was eased inside the furlong pole but walked off.
