Footnotes

CALLDEROLL never far back to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then dug in gamely through a long drive and wore down SUMMER ARROW late. The latter set the pace to the turn, turned back FIVE A DAY to the stretch, inched away to mid stretch then could not hold off the winner. KOFINHO was outprinted early, bid four wide on the turn, was bumped by KELLY'S GOLDEN WON and carried six wide into the stretch but finished willingly late. KELLY'S GOLDEN WON tracked the leaders to the turn, was bumped by SRIRACHA leaving the quarter pole, bumped KOFINHO while being carried five wide to the stretch then also finished well to the line. WARREN'S CONCEPT chased the pace to the turn then saved ground to no avail. SRIRACHA was outprinted early, bid two wide into the turn, angled out four wide and bumped KELLY'S GOLDEN WON at the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. FIVE A DAY prompted the pace early, offered his best bid mid turn while two wide, was outkicked by the runnerup to the stretch and gave way. LIGHTNING JAMES trailed throughout. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident involving SRIRACHA, KELLY'S GOLDEN WON and KOFINHO at the quarter pole and determined that SRIRACHA caused the problem and no change was warranted.
