Footnotes

FAST TRACK was not asked for speed early and raced just off the rail to the backstretch, moved closer into the second turn, responded four wide into the stretch and closed quickly to gain command late and won going away driving. HEROICALLY broke in stride and dueled inside PEPPERED PRO throughout, disposed of that rival leaving the furlong pole to briefly edge clear but could not hold the winner. WINTER WARLOCK steadied in traffic nearing the first turn but recovered and raced well placed behind the leaders and just off the rail into the stretch but lacked the needed response. GLOBAL GLOW steadied inside WINTER WARLOCK nearing the first turn in traffic, recovered to stalk the leaders from the inside to mid stretch, lacked room briefly but did not rally. COLONEL MUSTARD was void of any early speed, was forced to rally five wide into the stretch and finished with some speed. SIMPERIO was not asked for speed early from off the rail, tried to circle rivals six wide outside COLONEL MUSTARD to the stretch and closed too late. PEPPERED PRO dueled two wide into the stretch and gave way inside the furlong pole. CODYS A BOBCAT saved ground throughout but failed to rally. NEW CENTURION raced up three wide and between horses on the first turn to prompt the pace to the quarter pole and gave way. EL GRAN BEBE was fanned four wide while trying for the lead on the first turn then was through after five furlongs.
