SOURDOUGH SAM broke a bit slow and was not asked for speed, remained under patient handling to turn, was in three path while rallying into the stretch, came to the extreme outside for the drive and rallied boldly in the late stages to get up late and won going away impressively. SHUDACUDAWUDYA was never too far back, advanced two wide on the turn, took over from STARBOARDLIGHTS in the deep stretch but could not stall the winner. STARBOARDLIGHTS raced up inside in the opening quarter to dueled inside TRIBESMAN, bested that rival on the turn, edged clear in the upper stretch but slackened in the final sixteenth. OUR MINESWEEPER was permitted to settle early, advanced inside to the stretch but could not sustain his bid. TRIBESMAN dueled two wide into the stretch and gave out. SKIPSHOT settled early, was off the rail on the turn and did not response. HEXBREAKER tracked the pace three wide for a half mile and weakened. QUICK ENOUGH lacked early speed and did not respond.
