**Footnotes**

FRUMIOUS was rank in the early stages and again while pressing the pace when the loose horse pushed past him leaving the half mile pole, moved up three wide to challenge for the lead then was carried out seven wide by the loose horse into the stretch, bumped repeatedly with that one to mid stretch but dug in gamely late to prevail in impressive fashion. DAVE'S PACEMAKER chased the pace to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, loomed to mid stretch but was outfinished late. DELAWARE DOE had no speed, shifted off the rail into the stretch, drifted inward slightly nearing mid stretch then was also outfinished. UNLOCK THE CODE had good speed, set the pace to the turn, was collared into the stretch and could not produce the needed late response. A K RACER broke in a tangle, stalked the pace two wide to the stretch but also failed to rally. BILLIONAIRE BOB ducked inward nearing the end of the chute then straightened again suddenly and lost his rider. The stewards posted the inquiry sign after the finish of the race, looked at the start but did not alter the results.
