Footnotes

ROARING TIMES was a pace factor from the outset, bid two then three wide on the second turn, took a short lead to mid stretch then dug in gamely late to hold. DEACON SPEAKIN' contested the pace from the three path to the half, raced two wide while inching clear on the second turn, was collared in mid stretch but kept to task late. DEAL BREAKER (GB) never far back to the half, got fanned four wide while bidding on the second turn then closed determinedly late. CHIEF RUNAWAY stalked the leaders for five furlongs, raced two wide on the second turn then could not make an impact in the final furlong. STAR NICHOLAS was also a pace factor while saving ground to the second turn, got outrun to the stretch then finished evenly. EL CUGAT had no speed and trailed to the second turn, had to circle rivals five wide into the stretch but finished willingly.
