Footnotes

OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) broke inward and bumped DIXIE COMMANDER at the start, was sent to the front and set the pace to the second turn, turned back TAIF to the stretch then held driving. MASSONE chased the pace to the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch then shifted out and closed ground late. HOT CHACO was unhurried for a half mile, also rallied two wide to the stretch and was gaining in the late stages. TAIF prompted the pace to the second turn, offered his best bid three wide to draw alongside the winner at the five sixteenths but could not sustain the needed bid and weakened in the late going. SARATOGA BOOT was bumped by DIXIE COMMANDER and took up shortly after the start, settled for five furlongs, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. SILENT SALUTE had no speed and was not a threat. DIXIE COMMANDER was bumped by the winner at the start and knocked into SARATOGA BOOT, tracked the pace to the second turn, was four wide to the stretch and gave out.
