ROOSTER CITY took command in the opening strides, took the early first turn a bit wide but set all of the pace well in hand, drew off in the upper stretch and extended his advantage under steady urging from the furlong pole to the wire. MR. CANDY BAR settled early from the three patch, remained three wide on the second and came on for the place without bothering the winner. LIFE IS A ROCK was well rail from rail early, remained inside on the second turn but lacked a solid closing response. SARATOGA BOOT lagged early from the inside, moved out a closed a gap on the backstretch, came four wide to the stretch but flattened out. STALKING GOLD lacked good early speed, raced three wide on the second turn and failed to rally. NEWFOUND MAN was void of any early speed, angled four wide on the second turn but did not make any impact. LAMA CHANT was carried a bit wide early on the first turn while prompting the winner, remained a factor for six furlongs and stopped.
