SURFER DAVE never far back for a half, rallied four wide on the second turn, responded to take command leaving mid stretch then held on determinedly. ANNA'S MAGIC was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn then finished willingly in the final furlong. CLASSICAL BARTOK had no speed, came three wide to the stretch then closed steadily in the late stages. WARREN'S HOTROD was four wide early and settled, got roused three wide to the stretch and closed well in the late stages. KEMER BEE had no speed, circled four wide on the second turn then also was gaining well in the late going. KNIGHTSEN was hustled to the front after breaking alertly, set all the pace to the stretch but tired in the final furlong. GIFT N REGIFT tracked the pace to the second turn, was caught four wide to the stretch then came up empty in the drive. DANCE TO THE STORM stalked early, made a bid inside of KNIGHTSEN but was outkicked by that one to the half mile pole, shifted outside and bid again three wide on the second turn, took a short lead in upper

stretch but tired through the final eighth. GOLD CATEGORY was crowded some in the chute, settled inside to the second turn, offered a bid on the second turn but weakened through the stretch. WAVES OF HONOUR had no speed and was not a factor. CEE'S DIZZY was always outrun. MATERAZZI had speed to the second turn then stopped.
