LADY ASPEN took back early and raced unhurried from the rail to the second turn, circled rivals four wide to the stretch to take command once in the stretch and drew clear driving. NOISE OF THE CROWD tracked the leaders from off the rail, offered her best bid three wide on the second turn but could not go with the winner. DARK DOLORES settled early, remained unhurried to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch and finished steadily. WARREN'S GOT GAME trailed early two wide, tried to rally three wide on the second turn then lost her punch. GOTNACEUPERSLEEVE raced up two wide on the first turn to engage for the lead, dueled to the three eighths and came up empty. SMARTY CORN set the pace from the rail to the second turn and gave out.
