JUMEIMA broke cleanly and quickly made the lead without need of asking, drew clear on the turn and upper stretch then held her advantage while never being asked for speed. VINCENZA was well placed from the outset, advanced from the inside on the turn and closed a minor gap in the lane but was never a serious threat. COOL TODDY stalked the winner from the outside to mid turn and slackened. TIZ SHOCKING settled early, raced four wide on the turn and did not respond. HERE IT TIZ saved ground to no avail. GLORIOUS MADNESS was never a factor. OLYMPIO'S GAL was always outrun.
