APPEALING RESUME broke alertly but was permitted to sit back off the pace and tracked, raced just off the rail on the turn, responded leaving the furlong to rally inside CAN'T TOPPEER to gain command late and won going away driving. SOUL PATCH dueled outside LIT DE BET throughout, led past the furlong pole but could not withstand the winner. LIT DE BET dueled from the inside and slackened late. CAN'T TOPPER stalked the pace three wide but lacked the needed response in the stretch. SING FOR GOLD saved ground to no avail. POWERS LILSIS raced unhurried early, was three wide to the stretch and did not respond. COLD ROAR was always outrun.
