Footnotes

SLIM PICKINS was not asked for speed from the gate and raced unhurried from the outside to the second turn, remained out to circle rivals four wide to the stretch, challenged for the lead at the furlong pole then drew clear driving. TWO BUCKS TO WIN was forced out on the first turn while settling, advanced from the outside on the backstretch, offered his bid four wide on the second turn to gain command once in the stretch but could not hold the winner. DECKACARDS raced unhurried from the rail to the second turn, commenced his bid from the two path on the second turn but had only a mild rally. FASTER THAN DUKE was unhurried to the second turn then failed to rally from the outside. REDVETTE set the pace from off the rail and gave way three wide after six furlongs. GO CLEVER dueled from the rail to mid way on the second turn and slackened. ONE LUCKY GUY was never a factor. TWO PARTS drifted out into the first turn then settled, advanced from off the rail to gain command on the second turn but had little left for the drive.
