Footnotes

HANDFULL raced up from the outside into the first turn and drifted to the four path to the backstretch and settled, prompted the pace two wide, took command on the second turn, edged clear in the upper stretch then held gamely as usual. CALL THE TEN was unhurried early, advanced to contention through traffic into the second turn, was blocked from the three eighths to the head of the lane and raced in check, had a clear path once in the stretch but could not get to the winner. GITTEL settled early within striking distance, saved ground throughout and was gaining late. PERFECT SOULMATE was unhurried early from off the rail, raced four wide to the stretch but only had a mild rally. WHAT'S UP (IRE) stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs and faded. RUN THE BLUES AWAY was void of early speed, moved out and circled rivals five wide on the second turn but flattened out in the lane. BLUEGRASS STORY set the pace from the inside for six furlongs and slackened in the final furlong. DEMANDING DIVA stalked the pace three wide but came up empty when called upon.
