HIDDEN PASSION took command from the gate and set all of the pace under good rating, met a bid from BLAZINGLY in the upper stretch and drew clear again. BLAZINGLY stalked three wide, rallied into the stretch to challenge in the upper stretch but made no impact. JUMANAH was unhurried early from off the rail, split rivals three wide on the second turn to loom a threat once in the stretch then flattened out. DARK DOLORES was close up early from just off the rail, saved ground on the second turn but did not rally. JEWEL SEEKER was not asked for speed early, raced two wide on the second turn and passed tiring foes. ATTICUS' GHOST stalked the pace from the outset, was fanned four wide on the second turn and faded. LAST STING raced three and four wide throughout and did not respond. BELLAMINE saved ground to no avail.
