Footnotes

SEEINGISBELIEVING stalked the leaders to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn, battled the runnerup to mid stretch then dug in gamely late and inched away. RA'A ACTION had no speed and settled for a half, closed willingly three wide on the second turn, split rivals nearing the quarter pole, moved to duel to mid stretch but was outfinished late. TAYLOR MOUNTAIN never far back to the half, saved ground on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. TWO TURN GENERAL lugged out while showing speed early, was straightened and dueled for six furlongs but had nothing left for the stretch run. HALO'S HIGHWAY settled to the backstretch, tried to rally three deep on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. SO GONE had no speed and was not a factor. ROGUE RIVER dueled for the lead to stretch then gave out. SILVER STRUCK was fanned five wide early, tracked three wide to the second turn but stopped after six furlongs.
