STORMING KENTUCKY broke in stride and set the pace from the inside, turned back I WILL FOLLOW into the stretch to edge clear then held gamely. I WILL FOLLOW prompted the winner from the outset, had his best bid at the quarter pole, could not match strides to the furlong pole but finished steadily. WOODPULP was slow early, raced just off the rail on the turn, angled out for the drive and closed willingly. TWO STEP SATURDAY was never too far back, raced two wide on the turn but lacked the needed response. FOLLOW THROUGH was void of any early speed, caught stride on the turn, shifted to the outside for the drive and finished full of run. TOSS THE DICE was fractious in the gate then hopped at the break, showed good speed to mid turn and weakened. SOPHIE'S SEEKER settled early, was two wide on the turn but failed to respond. BRODMEISTER saved ground to no avail.
