LAYOVER IN SEATTLE broke alertly and dueled early in hand two wide, continued to engage for the lead between foes on the second turn, responded to fine handling in the lane and was up late. RACER MOBILE was never too far back, bid three wide on the second turn and was outdueled to the line. GANNICUS set the pace inside and gave way grudgingly. GAME OF KINGS lagged early, raced four wide on the second turn and finished steadily. MARY'S APP was permitted to settle early, advanced inside rivals on the second turn to reach serious contention, was behind a wall of leaders into the stretch, shifted out for room but lacked the needed response. EXTRA HOT lagged early, circled five wide on the second turn and lacked the needed response. BIG ROCK CANDI settled early, was four wide on the second turn and did not reach serious contention. DR. EVIL was well placed early, moved up four wide on the second turn but gave out in the lane. WORLD CONTRAST saved ground to no avail. GRAND GIZMO showed little.
