CHEROKEE CHEYENNE was settled to the turn, rallied inside to the stretch then continued to respond through the drive and edged clear. ESCAPE PLAN was outrun to the turn, bid two then three wide to the stretch, swung widest in the drive and came on in the final furlong. RUCKUSING STORM tracked the leaders to the turn, was asked for more three wide to the stretch then also finished steadily. MISS OOPS contested the pace inside to the stretch, responded to inch away to mid stretch but was tiring in the late stages. PERFECT CHOICE had no speed then saved ground to no avail. LA COLOMBINA was hustled and dueled for the lead from the two path to the stretch then stopped.
