WHERE'S WILSON allowed I'M A CLASSY GUY to take a long lead once on the backstretch, rallied steadily outside that rival on the second turn to take command once in the stretch, looked beaten at the furlong pole but kept to his task and held late. A STAR IS HERE raced unhurried early three wide, remained out on the second turn, rallied into the lane to loom a bold factor at the furlong pole but could not get by the winner. SEVENTEENMILEDRIIVE lagged early well off the rail, came three wide to the stretch and flattened out in the final furlong. VALDERON settled early, raced just off the rail on the second turn but lacked the needed response. I'M A CLASSY GUY broke on top and took a long lead once on the backstretch but was through after six furlongs. TONE was never a factor. DODGER was forwardly placed for a half mile and faded while saving ground on the second turn.
