Footnotes

TATTLETALE TONYA made the lead in the early stages under urging and set the pace to the stretch, was headed by TRUKISH SCOUT nearing the furlong pole but kept to his task and battled back to regain command late and won driving. TURKISH SCOUT was hustled from the gate and tracked the winner from the inside, eased out to challenge two wide at the quarter pole, gained a brief lead near the furlong pole but was outfinished in the late stages. CRIMSON SPORT was never too far back, angled off the rail near the quarter pole while stalking the leaders, dropped back to the rail for the drive but could not muster the needed response. THE FUTURE DEPUTY lagged early, circled four wide to the stretch but had only a mild closing kick. ATAGIRL GENIUS prompted the winner from the outside for a half mile and weakened. HEY TOOTS was never a serious factor. BUTTON BUTTON had no speed. POLKA SPOT stalked the pace from the extreme out and weakened while three wide on the turn. CAYUSE PASS had no speed.
