**Footnotes**

CAHILL COUNTRY broke alertly and stalked the pace from the outside, took command after a half mile and dueled to the stretch, responded in the lane and drew clear driving. LIGHTNIN' UP was permitted to settle early from the rail, raced two wide on the second turn then rallied between horses in mid stretch to gain the place. LANGFUHRIOUS set the early pace from the inside, was headed after a head mile but continued to battle into the lane then weakened. BOB'S BASS raced unhurried early, saved ground to the stretch but failed to rally. BRED ROYAL stalked the pace from the outset, had his best bid three wide on the second turn but flattened out in the lane. GEAR SHIFT took a favorable striking position from the inside, raced just off the rail on the second turn but did not respond. SPIRIT POWER lagged early then failed to respond while three wide on the second turn. FREEDOM'S HALO lacked good early speed and failed to rally from the inside in the final quarter. THE HUNT IS ON was never a factor. ROYAL REGIMENT flashed brief speed, stopped into the second turn and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
