### Footnotes

STALKING GOLD was unhurried to the half, advanced inside on the second turn, slipped to the front in upper stretch then edged away driving. THE HUNT IS ON was allowed to settle for a half, also advanced inside on the second turn then finished steadily without threatening the winner. GLOBAL STAGE set the pace to the second turn, was hooked nearing the quarter pole but battled gamely to deep stretch before weakening late. GET A GRIP (IRE) broke a bit slow and settled for a half, rallied three wide on the second turn, eased out and split rivals into the stretch but finished evenly in the final furlong. VELIKIY ZEVS tracked the pace to the half, was roused three wide on the second turn, briefly loomed a threat to the stretch but weakened in the drive. BALL BEARING prompted the pace outside of GLOBAL STAGE, offered her best bid two wide to duel for the lead on the second turn but gave way through the stretch. MANITOGA also broke a step slow and trailed to the second turn, raced four wide to mid turn, was forced out seven deep into the stretch and lost her punch. DRESS CODE settled mid pack for a half mile, was roused three then four wide to the stretch but came up empty through the lane. HIGHWAY BANDIT tracked the pace to the half, bid four wide into the second turn, was forced out six wide to the stretch and gave way.
