Footnotes

METTLER STATION stalked the leaders to the turn, was fanned four wide while rallying to the stretch then pushed to the front in mid stretch and edged clear under urging. TAKE A HARD LOOK had no speed, bid three then four wide to the stretch, did not switch leads in the lane but picked off foes to get the place. PARTNERSHIP PAYOUT was outsprinted to the turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch then failed to make an impact. MIG ALLEY had good speed, dueled between rivals to the turn, was two wide to the stretch, got outkicked by the winner to mid stretch and weakened. MY CHARMING CHANCE was among the leaders to the turn from the rail, got outkicked to the stretch, kept to task to mid stretch but was tiring late. WILLING WARRIOR ducked inward at the start and was taken up and straightened, chased to the turn, was three wide to the stretch then lacked a late response. RAPTOR FORCE was on the pace three wide to the stretch then tired.
