### Footnotes

ALLABOUTDREAMS was rated in the 'catbird seat' to the turn, rallied three wide and pushed to the front nearing mid stretch then was kept to task to the line. LUCKY CULPRIT was on the pace inside to the turn, responded to pressure to the stretch then was overtaken to mid stretch but dug in late to hold the place. BLUE LINE CAT was outside of LUCKY CULPRIT while dueling for the lead, also responded to mid stretch but was outfinished through the final furlong. EMERALD KNIGHT chased the leaders to the turn, came two wide to the stretch then had a mild late bid. HUMAN ERASER also was chasing the pace while two wide to the stretch, shifted out for room in upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. CLASSIC CRUSADER had no speed despite urging, lagged to the turn, raced three wide then swung widest into the stretch and was showing a bit of interest late. KING BILL tracked the pace to the turn, was fanned out four deep to the stretch then failed to rally in the drive.
