ELEGANT raced up outside to prompt the pace throughout, took command nearing the stretch, drew clear and held driving. FINAL STAND tracked the pace from the inside, raced just off the rail on the second turn, eased out once in the stretch and finished steadily but could make no impact. LILLY'S PERFECT steadied inside COVER STORY entering the first turn, recovered and saved ground to the stretch then came on for the show. TWO THIRDS VICTORY stalked the pace three wide for six furlongs and weakened. COVER STORY raced unhurried, was two wide on both turns but lacked the needed response. GOLD COAST STRIKER set all of the pace from the inside to the stretch and gave way. FLIGHT OF A DREAM lagged early from the three path, was just off the rail on the second turn but did not rally. RUNAWAY COMET was never a factor.
