Footnotes

PASS THE HEAT bobbled slightly at the start then was outsprinted to the first turn, chased to the half, moved up inside into the second turn but was boxed on the rail through the second turn, shifted out in upper stretch and found room, spurred to the front in mid stretch and drew clear under steady urging. SARATOGA'S MAGIC had good speed, dueled two to the second turn, was overtaken in mid stretch then outfinished COVER MAGIC for the place. COVER MAGIC drifted out on the first turn and crowded foes, dueled from the rail to the second turn, remained inside to the stretch, was a factor to mid stretch then was outfinished in the late stages. ASSESSMENT was crowded between rivals on the first turn, prompted the leaders to the half, came three wide to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. SOUTHERN AFRICA had no speed and was not a factor. MUSCLE 'N MANE tracked the pace to the backstretch, offered his best bid while widest into the second turn then drifted out into the stretch and gave way.
