DEFENSIVE MOVE was hustled along early and dueled the runnerup to the turn, saw that one edge away, raced three wide to the stretch then responded to strong pressure and inched away in the final sixteenth. VADERATOR broke alertly and was clear leaving the chute, dueled the winner to the turn, edged away while off the rail to the stretch then responded, stayed with the winner to the sixteenth marker but was bested late. FOLLOWS NONE was outsprinted early, chased the pace to mid turn, raced two wide into the stretch then could not muster the needed response. YOU'RE MY BOY BLUE tracked the leaders to the turn, was three wide to the stretch then also could not make an impact late. R SPRING AFFAIR had no speed, was forced to circle five wide on the turn then went evenly in the drive. HIGH LODDE chased the pace to the turn, was four wide to the stretch then weakened in the final furlong.
