Footnotes

GONE PARTY HOPPIN broke cleanly and took a forward position from the outset, advanced two wide on the second turn to challenge for command, drew clear in the upper stretch then was kept to his task to the line without need of the whip. YYYYES lagged early from the rail, advanced two wide on the second turn and finished willingly without bothering the winner. FITS THE ROUTE broke off balance and lost her irons at the break, recovered nearing the first turn and quickly sprinted to a clear lead, settled on the backstretch but gave way gradually on the second turn. LITELUCKY stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn and weakened. TAPS FOR LIBERTY was well placed from the outside to the second turn then failed to respond when called upon. KICKABOOM had no early speed then passed tiring horses. MY STRAWBERRY stalked the pace two wide to the half mile pole and faded. ROYAL N'SWEET was never a serious factor. GENTLE RIDGE lugged out sharply into the first turn, steadied and was never a factor.
