FALLING KNIFE broke alertly then was taken back off the pace and went unhurried to the second turn, dropped inside for the drive, offered a quick bid to take command leaving the furlong pole and drew off driving then pulled up lame and was vanned off. LODI RED settled early, raced two wide to the stretch, angled out and finished steadily. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) lagged early, saved ground on both turns and closed ground. GREY STORM stalked the pace from off the rail to the stretch, had his best bid near the furlong pole and gave way. RED COATS R COMIN sprinted to a long lead, maintained an advantage to the furlong pole and slackened. TWIN'S TITAN was forwardly placed from off the rail for six furlongs and weakened. TUCKY showed little. SUMMER SUNSHINE broke in the air at the start then hopped in the opening strides, raced up three wide for six furlongs and gave out.
