Footnotes

MAH GELLIN was never too far back while racing well off the rail, advanced four wide into the lane to gain command near the furlong pole and held determinedly. GIANT EGO dueled two wide from the outset, responded in the lane and lost a head bob in a game effort. MARSHAL MARINI settled early, circled rivals five wide to the stretch and came on but did not bother the top two. GAL HAS TO LIKE IT stalked three wide into the stretch and slackened. URBAN HUNTER dueled inside into the stretch and slackened. CHARLIE COMPANY raced in tight quarters between horses from the outset, remained in check behind traffic on the turn and through the lane then had no response once room did develop. GO MOJAVE GO lacked early speed, raced five wide on the turn and failed to rally. MICKEY BALL raced close up in tight quarters on the rail to mid turn, then steadied back and could not recover. JOHNSKI tracked the pace in heavy traffic, was two wide on the turn and failed to respond. FONZ lacked early speed, was forced six wide to the stretch and went evenly.
